NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the National Atlas Organisation (Senior Librarian) Recruitment Rules, 1979 except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Senior Librarian in the National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement.-(1) These rules may be called the National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation (Senior Librarian) Recruitment Rules, 1989.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of post, its classification and scale of pay.—The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc.—The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post, shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification—No person, -

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted marriage with any person.

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied, that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Note 2 :- The qualification regarding experience is relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes if at any stage of selection, the Union Public Service Commission is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them.

- Desirable:-
- (i) Master's Degree in Library Science of a recognised University or equivalent
 - (ii) Experience of documentation work in a responsible capacity.
 - (iii) Working knowledge of modern European language other than English.

(b) possessing the educational qualifications and experience as prescribed for Direct Recruits in Column 8.

2. The Departmental Map Curator with two years regular service in that grade will also be considered alongwith outsiders and in case he is selected he will be deemed to have been promoted to the post. (Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same organisation/Department shall not exceed 3 years)(The Departmental officers in the feeder grade who are in direct line of promotion

Note:- The proceedings of the Departmental Promotion Committee relating to confirmation shall be sent to the Commission for approval; if, however these are not approved by the Commission a fresh meeting of the Departmental Promotion

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will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion).
Committee to be presided over by the Chairman or Member of Union Public Service Commission shall be held.
