G.S.R. 526.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to Group 'C' and 'D' posts in Departmental Canteen in the National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation under the Department of Science and Technology, namely :—

1. Short title and Commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation Departmental Canteen Employees Group 'C' and 'D' posts Recruitment Rules, 2002.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Number of post, classification and scale of pay.**—The number of said posts, their classification and scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualification, etc.**—The method of the recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Schedule.

4. **Initial constitution.**—The incumbents of the posts mentioned in the Schedule shall be deemed to have been appointed under these rules and the services rendered by them in the said post shall be taken into account for deciding their eligibility for promotion to the next higher grade.

5. **Disqualification.**—No person,—

- (a) who, has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post :

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. **Power to relax.**—where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do; it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. **Saving.**—Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservations, and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the Orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

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
