G.S.R. 70.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation (Group 'C' and 'D' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1988 and partial supersession of in the National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation (Stenographer Grade I, Grade II and Grade III) Recruitment Rules, 1994, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to Group 'C' and 'D' posts in the National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation under the Department of Science and Technology, namely :—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation (Group "C" and Group "D" posts) Recruitment Rules, 2004.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Application.—These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 1 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Number of Posts, classification and scale of pay.—The number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the said Schedule.

4. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications etc.—The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Schedule.

5. Initial Constitution.—The incumbents of the posts mentioned in first column of the Schedule annexed to the rules holding the same on the date of commencement of these rules shall be deemed to have been appointed to the respective posts under these rules.

6. Disqualification.—No person,—

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts :

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

7. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

8. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-Servicemen, Backward classes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

(Period of deputation including period of deputation in another cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall not be exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.)
