Notification

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GSR - In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the National Atlas & Thematic Mapping Organisation (Senior Personal Assistant) Recruitment Rules, 1991, namely:-

- (1) These rules may be called the National Atlas & Thematic Mapping Organisation (Senior Personal Assistant) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2000.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Schedule to the National Atlas & Thematic Mapping Organisation (Senior Personal Assistant) Recruitment Rules, 1991, namely :-

- (i) in column 4, for the existing entry, the following entry shall be substituted, namely :-

"Rs.6500-200-10500" ;

- (ii) in column 11, for the existing entries, the following entries shall be substituted, namely :-

Heading : "Method of recruitment whether by direct recruitment or by promotion or by deputation/absorption and percentage of posts to be filled by various methods."

"Promotion/failing which by Deputation."

- (iii) in column 12, for the existing entries, the following entries shall be substituted :-

Heading : "In case of recruitment by promotion/deputation/absorption, grades from which promotion/deputation/absorption to be made.";

Promotion/Deputation: -

- (1) Stenographers of the Central Government :-
 - (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis; or
 - (ii) with 3 years regular service in the scale of Rs.5500-9000 or equivalent;

2. The departmental Stenographers Grade-I in the scale of Rs.5500-9000 with 3 years regular service as Stenographer Grade-I will also be considered along with outsiders and in case he is selected he will be deemed to have been promoted as Senior Personal Assistant.

(Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation/department of the Central Government shall not exceed 3 years).

NOTIFICATION

G.S.R. 294 In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation (Senior Personal Assistant) Recruitment Rules, 1989, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Senior Personal Assistant in the National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation, Calcutta, namely : -

1. (1) Short title and commencement - These rules may be called the National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation (Senior Personal Assistant) Recruitment Rules, 1991.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of post, Classification and scale of pay - The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications - The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification - No person,
(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,
shall be eligible for appointment to the said post :

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by

order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving :- Nothing in these rules shall affect reseervations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-Servicemen and other special category of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
