Notification

GSR - In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation (Senior Administrative Officer) Recruitment Rules, 1990, namely:-

- (1) These rules may be called the National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation (Senior Administrative Officer) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2000.
  - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. In the Schedule to the National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation (Senior Administrative Officer) Recruitment Rules, 1990, -
- (i) in column 4, for the entry, the following entry shall be substituted, namely :-  
"Rs.8000-275-13500" ;
  - (ii) in column 5, for the entry, the following entry shall be substituted, namely :-  
"Selection-cum-seniority for promotion & Selection by merit for direct recruitment."
  - (iii) in column 11, for the entries, the following entries shall be substituted, namely :-  
Heading : "Method of recruitment whether by direct recruitment or by promotion or by deputation/absorption and percentage of posts to be filled by various methods."  
"By promotion/deputation failing which by direct recruitment.";



- (iv) in column 12, for the entries, the following entries shall be substituted :-

Heading : "In case of recruitment by promotion/deputation/absorption, grades from which promotion/deputation/absorption to be made.";

"Promotion/Deputation : -

(1) Central or State Government officers:

(a) (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis ; or

(ii) in the grade of Rs.6500-10500/- with 3 years' regular service in that grade or equivalent; or


(iii) in the grade of Rs.5500-9000 with 5 years regular service in that grade or equivalent; and

(b) having experience in administration, establishment and account matters.

2. Departmental Administrative Officers with 3 years' regular service in that grade will also be considered alongwith outsiders and in case he is selected, the post will be deemed to have been filled by promotion.

(Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same organisation/department shall not exceed 3 years.)

The departmental officers in the feeder grade who are in direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion."

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Senior Administrative Officer (National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation) Recruitment Rules, 1972, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following Rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Senior Administrative Officer in the National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation, namely : -

1. Short title and commencement (1) These rules may be called the National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation (Senior Administrative Officer) Recruitment Rules, 1990.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number, classification and scale of pay- The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, other matters; etc.- The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit,



qualification and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification - No person, --

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
  - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,
- shall be eligible for appointment to the said post; Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
