Notification

GSR - In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation (Manager) Recruitment Rules, 1990, namely:-

- (1) These rules may be called the National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation (Manager) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2000.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Schedule to the National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation (Manager) Recruitment Rules, 1990, -

- (i) in column 4, for the entry, the following entry shall be substituted, namely :-

"Rs.8000-275-13500" ;

- (ii) in column 11, for the entries, the following entries shall be substituted, namely :-

Heading : "Method of recruitment whether by direct recruitment or by promotion or by deputation/absorption and percentage of posts to be filled by various methods."

"By promotion/Deputation failing which by direct recruitment.";

- (iii) in column 12, for the entries, the following entries shall be substituted :-

Heading : "In case of recruitment by promotion/deputation/absorption grades from which promotion/deputation/absorption to be made.";

"Promotion/Deputation:

Deputation:

1. Officers of the Central/State Governments :-

(a) (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis ; or

- (ii) holding posts in the grade of Rs.6500-10500 with 3 years regular service or equivalent ;
- (iii) holding posts in the grade of Rs.5500-9000 with 3 years regular service in the grade or equivalent ; and
- (b) Possessing the educational qualification and experience prescribed for direct recruits under Column 8.

2. Departmental Assistant Manager with 3 years regular service in the grade will also be considered along-with outsides and in case he is selected the post will be deemed to have been filled by promotion.

(Period of deputation including deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same organisation/department shall not exceed 3 years)

(The departmental officers in the feeder grade who are in direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion).

NOTIFICATION

GSR No. 127 In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the National Atlas Organisation, Instructor (Printing) Recruitment Rules 1977, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Manager, National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation, Calcutta, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement - (1) These rules may be called the National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation (Manager) Recruitment Rules, 1990.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of post, classification and scale of pay - The number of the post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc. - The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification - No person -

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

sufficient number of candidates from
these communities possessing the
requisite experience are not likely
to be available to fill up the vacancies

Departmental Assistant Manager with 3 years regular service in the grade will also be considered alongwith outsiders and in case he is selected the post will be deemed to have been filled by promotion. (Period of deputation including deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same organisation/department shall not exceed 3 years)
