N O T I F I C A T I O N

GSR No. *672* In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of -

- (1) the National Atlas Organisation (class I and class II posts) Recruitment Rules, 1963; and
- (2) the National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation, Technical Officer (Grade 'A' Gazetted) Recruitment Rules, 1985,

except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby merges the posts of Research Officer, Technical Officer and Drawing Officer and redesignates the merged posts as Research Officer and makes the following rules, regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Research Officer in the National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation, Calcutta, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement:- (1) These Rules may be called the National Atlas and Thematic Mapping Organisation (Research Officer) Recruitment Rules, 1989.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Number of post, classification and scale of pay:- The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc.:- The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post, shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Schedule.
4. Disqualification:- No person -
(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a

person having a spouse living, or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall not be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied, that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax:- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving:- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-service-men and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.



Commission in case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes if at any stage of selection, the Union Public Service Commission is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities with requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them.
Desirable:-

- (i) Doctorate in Geography or Geology.
- (ii) Experience of aerial-photo interpretation/remote sensing.

(b) possessing the educational qualifications and experience prescribed for direct recruits under column 8.

(The departmental officers in the feeder grade who are in direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion).
